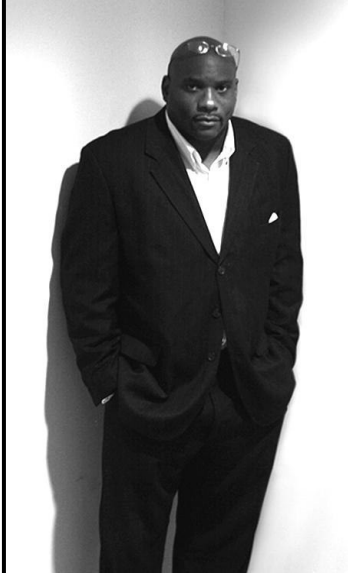


2010 SENG KIDS' FILM CONTEST

Rich Ferguson-Hull is an Animation Director working primarily in the fields of television and advertising. He recently co-wrote, executive produced, and directed a pilot for Cartoon Network entitled *Avery Matthews*. He is currently involved in directing a new pilot for the same network, and developing a show for WGBH in Boston. Rich previously was the Supervising Director for *Harvey Birdman, Attorney at Law*, part of Cartoon Network's late night animation block [adult swim]. In 2005, the *Harvey Birdman* Episode "Birdgirl of Guatanamole" won Best Animated Series For Adults at the Ottawa International Animation Festival. Prior to directing that series, Ferguson-Hull spent nine years at Olive Jar Studios of Boston and Los Angeles, first as animator and director, and later as a Creative Director. He is currently represented for commercial work through Global Mechanic. Rich received his BA in Film Studies from Wesleyan University. He works from his studio in Connecticut, where he lives with his wife and two sons.



A native of Connecticut, **Joe Young** is a cartoonist, filmmaker, producer, and writer. The creator of the *Scruples* comic characters, he is currently the president and founder of Young Studios headquartered in Hartford, CT. He is a former Guinness World Record holder for creating the World's Longest Comic Strip. In 1999 he received the Daily Point of Light Award from the White House. He has appeared in *People*, *Ebony* and *Jet* Magazines, the *New York Times*, *Boston Globe*, *C-Span*, *US Weekend* and other national media outlets.



Stephen Mills has been painting since the age of three. In 2005, Stephen received The Connecticut Renewal Team's National Arts Program Award. Stephen was the youngest person in Connecticut to ever receive this award. Stephen exhibited his paintings as part of a three generation art show at the West Hartford Library in April, 2005. His works were on display at CRT in Hartford as part of a two person art show entitled, *Strokes of Genius* in September, 2005. His painting, *Poinsettias*, was chosen to be represented on holiday cards for the 2006 Children's Medical Center's holiday fundraiser. Stephen's art was selected in an international contest in 2007 to appear on the cover of *It's All in Your Head, Around the World in 80 Lyme Patient Stories* by PJ Langhoff. In 2008, Stephen was featured on *Viva Hartford*. From 2008-present Stephen has had a one-person show running at Young Studios, entitled, *Strokes of Genius 2*. Stephen has been recognized on Channel 30 News and Fox TV news. He studies privately with nationally recognized artist Joe Young, Young Studio Artists, and Rich Ferguson-Hull, a Director for The Cartoon Network.
