

## **Authors: Guidelines for Article Submission**

SENGVine, SENG's monthly eNewsletter, welcomes manuscripts from educators, parents, counselors, and other stakeholders within the gifted education field of study. Manuscripts should be aligned with mission, vision, and values of SENG. They should be crafted through the lens of social and emotional support and development. SENGVine is a juried publication, with manuscripts evaluated by members of the editorial board and/or other reviewers.

Please keep in mind the following when submitting manuscripts:

1. Manuscripts should be 500-1200 words on a topic related to the social and emotional needs of gifted individuals.
2. References should follow the APA style outlined in the sixth edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association.
3. Place any tables, figures, illustrations, and photographs on separate pages. Each should have a title and be referenced in the text. Submit electronically with manuscript.
4. Author(s) is fully responsible for accuracy of quotations, citations, figures, and facts.
5. Author(s) of accepted manuscripts, in agreement, transfers copyright to *SENGvine*, which holds copyright to all articles and reviews.
6. Submit an electronic copy, typed, 12 pt. font, double-spaced manuscript as an attachment to a cover email to include the author's name, title, school or program affiliation, home and work address, e-mail address, and phone numbers.
7. Upon acceptance of a manuscript, the author(s) submits a 25–50 word biography.

## **Feedback and Next Steps:**

Once the corresponding author has emailed the managing editor, s/he can expect to:

1. Receive a confirmation of receipt from the managing editor within 48 hours of submission.
2. Manuscript to be sent to assigned reviewers within one (1) week of submission.
3. Receive notification of decision within 45 days of submission
4. Authors of accepted manuscripts will also receive any further directions and expected publication month.
